

GRANT POLICY

1. The main purpose of the grants is to support young researchers in finishing their doctoral thesis. Grants are awarded based on each Foundation's and each Fund's rules (some grants only available for certain research areas).
2. Only exceptionally post doctoral-research work can be supported. The grants are not awarded to master's thesis work.
3. Grants are awarded as personal grants to be used for full-time research free from other obligations. Grants are not meant for travelling cost, equipment or material purchases.
4. Applicant cannot be awarded a grant to same research consecutive years from the same foundation.
5. Grantees must give a written report using to the Foundation by end of the following year the grant was awarded.

REQUIREMENTS OF THE GRANT APPLICATIONS

1. All applications must be made using Foundation's electronic grant application system.
2. Addition to the information filled in the application system, applicants must include **one PDF-file** which consists of the following documents (total length of PDF is *max. 6 pages* using font size 12):
 - a. Curriculum Vitae (CV), *please clearly list the publications to be included applicant's doctoral thesis* (1-2 pages)
 - b. Summary of Applicant's research plan (max. 3-4 pages)
 - c. Statement of Applicant's Supervisor (1 page)
